**TEMPORARY MEMBERSHIP FEE** Prospective members pay the Club entrance fee of £30. This includes provisional membership for a period of six months. It entitles temporary members to use club boats, attend Wednesday evenings, any additional sailing support sessions when arranged and Sunday racing if the temporary member is assessed as competent.

Non -sailors and beginners who are not confident sailing without another experienced sailor should sign up for our Learn to Sail Programme which involves an additional fee. Those who complete the course can then expect to use club boats on a Wednesday evening throughout the summer to practise their newly learnt skills. In addition they can come along to Family Sunday afternoons, dates to be advised, as another option to continue sailing practise. When confident new members can come along and join in Sunday Racing.

INFORMATION FOR NEW MEMBERS We offer Wednesday Night sailing from May to end of August starting from 6pm until sundown usually 9pm in June and 8pm by mid August. when it ends. Sunday Family Sailing afternoons will operate on a limited number of dates which will be advised during good summer weather and is subject to being run by volunteers. from 1pm to 4pm.

Member Obligations include carrying out two duties in each Winter and Summer season. Duties involve helping the Race Officer prepare the jetty, opening up the club house, marking off boats on a schedule, making coffee for mid race break and helping put equipment away before locking up the clubhouse and boat park at the end. Family members may become involved with running Sunday afternoon activities such as helping to rig, launch and retrieve boats, or organising quiz and colouring activities on

shore. All club activities are run by volunteer members so joining the club involves helping out in some form as there are no paid staff but the benefits are that are fees are very good value for money.
